Vendor Information & Requirements

- Artists & Artisans Only. Applications will be reviewed individually.
 - art·ist: a person who practices any of the various creative arts (painter, sculptor, novelist, poet, photography, etc)
 - ar·ti·san: a worker in a skilled trade, especially one that involves making things by hand (textiles, ceramics, leather, etc)
- Exhibitors are required to pay a fee of \$35 per 12'x12' space.
- Submission of application does not guarantee your space. The committee will review each application and you will be notified of your acceptance. The committee reserves the right to accept or reject any application. Your booth fee will be returned for those that are rejected. A description of your work and materials used must be included with your application. You will be able to unload and park directly or very near your vendor space.
- This is an outside venue. All spaces are 12'x12'. Do not bring awnings or weather covers that require a larger ground space. This event takes place rain or shine. Please plan accordingly for items to secure your tent as it can get windy along the St Lawrence River.
- Rain Location: Cape Vincent Fire Hall Reception Room
- There is no electric or water hook-up available.
- All trash/garbage of individual crafters must be removed from site by crafter.
- Booth set up is 8am-10am on Saturday, earlier setup available as needed. ABSOLUTELY NO tear downs until after 5pm. You may not be considered for future years if you tear down early. You can stay as late as you choose, music ends at 7pm.
- Each exhibitor should provide their own display materials, tables, chairs, overhead coverings, etc. and be responsible for his/her own property. All displays must be neat and professional.
